

The estimated growing cost of osteoporosis and fragility fractures to healthcare systems in top 5 European countries*



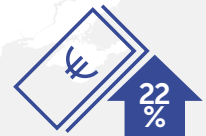
Every year, **2.5 million fractures** occur across the top 5 European countriesⁱ



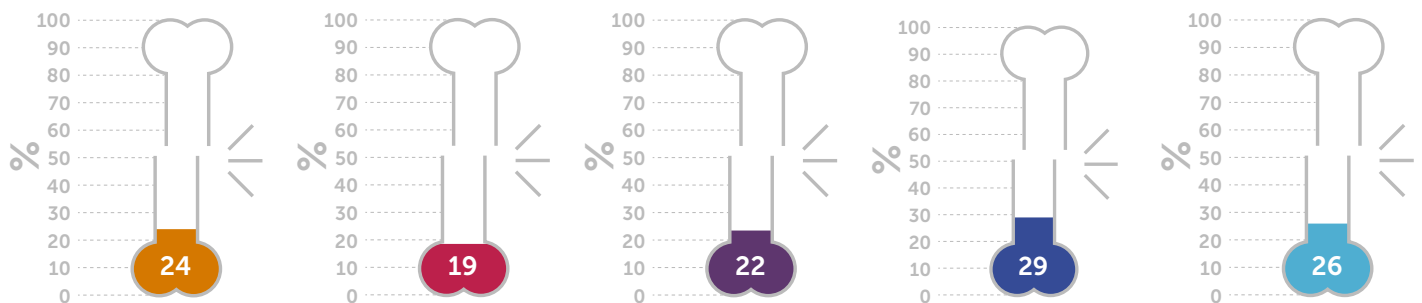
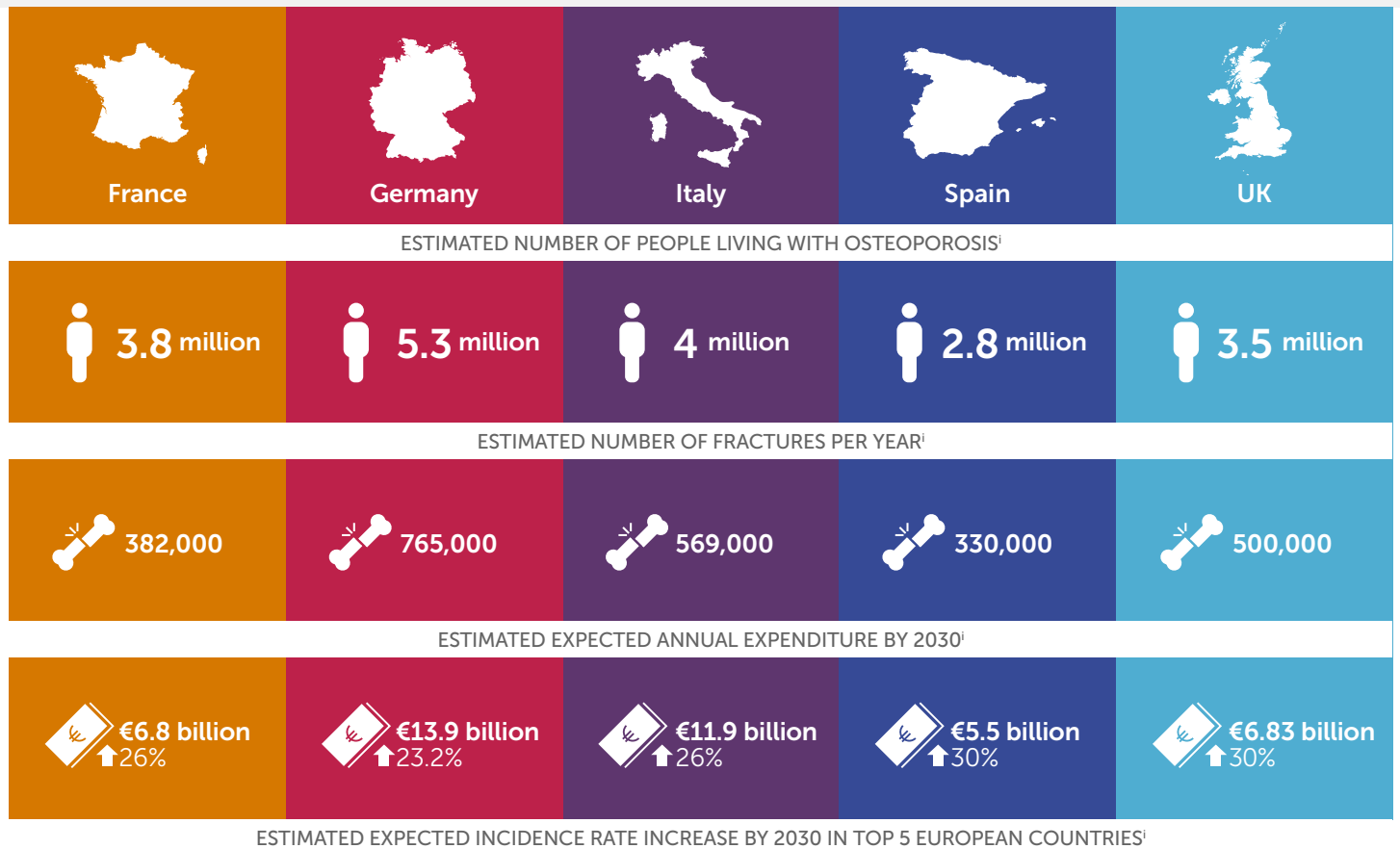
with an associated healthcare cost of **€35 billionⁱ**
